CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
prohibiting the forced implantation of a microchip or  
other permanent mark; authorizing the State  
Department of Health to impose a fine in certain  
circumstances; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1430 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No person, state, county, or local governmental entity or  
corporate entity may require an individual to undergo the implanting  
of a microchip or permanent mark of any kind or nature upon the  
individual.

1 B. The State Department of Health may impose a fine not to  
2 exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) on any person who violates  
3 this act. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a  
4 separate offense.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
